The Mennel Milling KSU Scholarship Program

Scholarship Award Amount

- One (1) award level is available to successful applicants:
 - The Mennel Milling scholarship award will allow for non-Kansas resident students to attend Kansas State University at the cost of in-state tuition. For example, current out-of-state tuition is approximately \$15,800 annually, vs. \$5,800 annually for in-state tuition. Mennel's scholarship award will cover this difference (an approximate \$10,000/yr value.) In addition, Mennel's scholarship will provide for an additional \$1,000 per year to cover student travel expenses. Approximately \$11,000 in total scholarship award value.

Duration of Awards

- Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis, and students are eligible for a renewal of the awarded scholarship each year. Assuming the student remains in good academic standing while enrolled at Kansas State University, the scholarship will automatically renew for the next school year. Students may receive the scholarship for a maximum of four (4) years.

Scholarship Award Criteria

- **Eligible Applicants**
 - Only applicants who reside in the below counties adjacent to Mennel's operating facilities are eligible for consideration:
 - Fostoria and Bucyrus, OH mills: Hancock, Wood, Seneca, Sandusky, Crawford, Wyandot, Allen, and Hardin.
 - Mt. Olive, IL mill: Macoupin, Jersey, Greene, Morgan, Sangamon, Montgomery, and Madison.
 - Dowagiac, MI mill: Cass, Berrien, Van Buren, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph (MI), St. Joseph and Elkhart (IN).
 - Roanoke, VA mill: Roanoke, Craig, Botetourt, Franklin, Bedford, Floyd, and Montgomery.

- Foraker Elevator – Alger, OH: Auglaize, Logan, Union, and Marion.
 - Mexico, IN Elevator: Miami, Wabash, Fulton, Cass, Howard, and Grant.
 - Valley Grain Elevator, Kingston, OH: Ross, Pickaway, Fayette, Highland, Pike, Jackson, Vinton, and Hocking.
 - Troy, OH Elevator: Miami, Darke, Montgomery, Clark, Champaign, and Shelby.
 - Old Dominion Grain, West Point, VA: New Kent, Hanover, Henrico, Charles City, James City, King and Queen, and King William.
- All eligible students who are the children of any Mennel Milling employee are also eligible to apply, regardless of their state or county of residence.
- High school students in their senior year (incoming college freshmen) must be enrolled full time in the Milling Science & Management – Operations curriculum at Kansas State University.
- Current college students or KSU transfers: students must be enrolled in the Milling Science & Management – Operations curriculum at Kansas State University to be eligible.
- **Award Restrictions**
 - Restricted to full-time students only.
 - Only students enrolled in Milling Science & Management – Operations curriculum at Kansas State University are eligible for this scholarship.
- **Primary Award Criteria**
 - All eligible applicants must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA in high school.
 - All applicants must have scored a 21 or higher on the ACT standardized test.
 - All applicants must complete and submit an online application by going to Kansas State’s financial aid website at: <http://www.k-state.edu/sfa/scholarships/> and then click on the “apply for K-State scholarships” link.
 - All applicants must participate in a personal interview process with the Mennel Milling scholarship committee.
 - Applicants must submit a letter of acceptance from Kansas State University.
 - All students must submit a copy of current high school and/or college transcripts.
 - Other criteria that will be considered:
 - Demonstrated leadership activities
 - Academic awards and achievement
 - Athletic awards and achievement
 - Community and extracurricular activities
 - Participation in agricultural based activities
 - Work history
 - Character
 - Award recipients must remain in good academic standing while enrolled at Kansas State. Transcripts must be submitted to Mennel Milling after each completed semester for verification purposes.

- Award recipients must also complete at least one summer internship at either a Mennel Milling flour mill, or at another flour milling company within our industry during their enrollment at Kansas State University. An internship summary report must be submitted to Mennel Milling upon completion of the internship.
- **Application Procedures**
 - Eligible applicants should complete an online application form that can be found at Kansas State’s financial aid website: <http://www.k-state.edu/sfa/scholarships/> and then clicking on the “apply for K-State scholarships” link.
 - Copies of applicable transcripts and your KSU acceptance letter must also be sent to the following email address: **dmarty@mennel.com**
 - The application process opens January 1st of each year.
 - Applications are to be completed by no later than April 30th of the upcoming academic year.
 - Selected scholarship recipients will be notified via mail by no later than May 31st of the upcoming academic year.

Selection Procedures

- The Mennel Milling Scholarship Selection Committee will be comprised of the following personnel: The Company President, the Director of Operations, the Corporate Milling Engineer, the Plant Manager of the closest Mennel facility to the applicant’s residence, as well as other Kansas State University administration personnel.
- Once all of the selection documentation has been submitted and candidate interviews have been completed, the committee will review all of the gathered information and select the best applicant(s), based on the above pre-determined criteria and overall merit.

Scholarship Award Disbursement

- The scholarship award will be disbursed directly to Kansas State University Foundation where it will be applied to the selected student’s tuition costs.
